



WARNING - NOTICE OF MEETING - May 8, 2018

The qualified voters of the City of Winooski are hereby warned and notified that a Special City Meeting will be held for the object and purpose to consider indebtedness for the purpose of certain public improvements for the City, known as the WINOOSKI MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROJECT, consisting of planning, design, construction and reconstruction of the Winooski Main Street corridor, including upgrades to existing water, wastewater, electric and telecommunication facilities, stormwater, roadway, streetscape, traffic, and landscape elements, sidewalk and road improvements. The estimated cost of the improvements is \$23,000,000; the amount of bonds proposed to be issued is \$23,000,000, but such amount may be reduced by the receipt of federal and state grants and aid.

The following question will be voted by Australian ballot on May 8, 2018, at the Winooski Senior Center, 123 Barlow Street, in the City of Winooski between the hours of (7:00) seven o'clock in the morning, at which time the polls will open, and (7:00) seven o'clock in the evening, at which time the polls will close. The legal voters of the City of Winooski are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Chapter 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

Shall the bonds of the City of Winooski in an amount not to exceed Twenty Three Million Dollars (\$23,000,000), be issued for the purpose of the planning, design and construction of improvements for the City, known as the WINOOSKI MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROJECT, consisting of planning, design, construction and reconstruction of the Winooski Main Street corridor, including upgrades to existing water, wastewater, electric and telecommunication facilities, stormwater, roadway, streetscape, traffic, and landscape elements, sidewalk and road improvements, with the amount of the bonded indebtedness to be reduced by the receipt of federal and state grants and aid?

Pursuant to 17 V.S.A. §2680, the qualified voters of the City of Winooski are hereby warned and notified that a Public Informational Meeting will be held on May 7, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Claire Burke Council Chamber, Winooski City Hall, 27 West Allen Street. The object and purpose of this hearing is to consider indebtedness for the purpose of improvements for the City, known as the WINOOSKI MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROJECT, consisting of planning, design, construction and reconstruction of the Winooski Main Street corridor, including upgrades to existing water, wastewater, electric and telecommunication facilities, stormwater, roadway, streetscape, traffic, and landscape elements, sidewalk and road improvements. The estimated cost of the improvement is \$23,000,000; the amount of bonds proposed to be issued is \$23,000,000, but such amount may be reduced by the receipt of federal and state grants and aid.
